Objectives and investment policy

Objectives

The objective of this fund is to generate a positive return regardless of market conditions. The fund is accumulating.

Investment policy

The fund invests mainly in equities and equity related securities in companies domiciled in or with main activity in Europe. The fund can invest a small part in securities domiciled in or traded on regulated markets in countries outside Europe.

The risk management of the fund is an important part of the portfolio management. Ideally, the risk management contributes to both minimizing the risk and improving the possibilities for a higher return. The risk is reduced by minimizing the sensitivity against movements in

the equity market and by diversifying the investments on approx. 25-35 different strategies which typically consist of one long position and several short positions which will only be taken via financial derivative instruments.

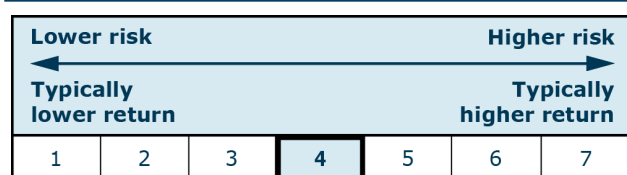
The main part of the fund's NAV will be hedged against the base currency of the fund. However, the fund remains exposed to the currencies of the investments in the fund.

Recommendation: This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 3 years.

Benchmark

The fund has no benchmark.

Risk and reward profile



The fund is categorized as 4. The indicator illustrates the typical correlation between the risk and your potential return of the investment. The categorization is determined by the fluctuations in the fund's net asset value over the past five years and/or representative data.

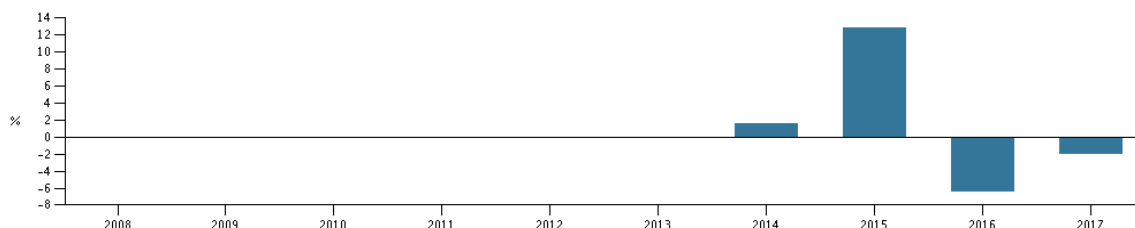
