The fund systematically integrates ESG factors alongside financial factors and material ESG issues are addressed and promoted through active ownership.

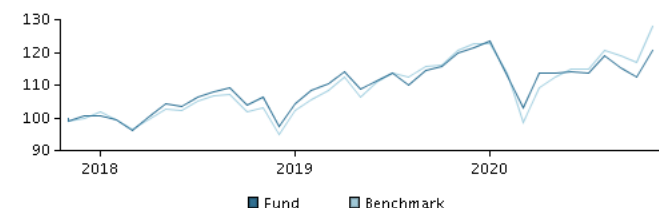
In actively managing the fund's portfolio, the management team selects securities that appear to offer superior investment characteristics.

The fund generally expects that its holdings, and therefore its performance, may differ significantly from those of the benchmark.

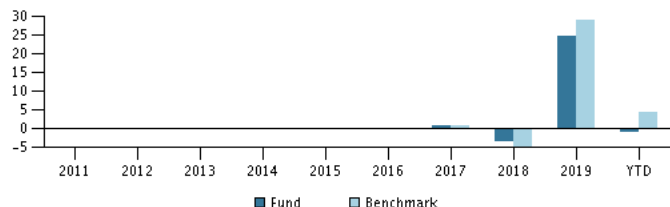
The fund may use derivatives for hedging and efficient portfolio management.

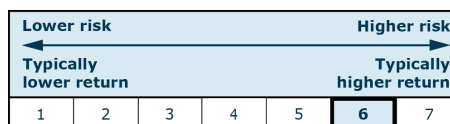
