This fund is managed by Danske Invest Management Company, part of the Danske Bank group.

Objectives and investment policy

Objectives

The objective of this fund is to achieve a combination of stable income and long-term investment growth [total return]. Specifically, the fund seeks to outperform the EURIBOR 3 Month money market rate. The share class is accumulating.

Investment policy

The fund is broadly diversified to minimize asset class specific risks. The fund invests directly in transferable securities listed or traded on regulated markets and money market instruments. The fund also invests in units or shares of other open-ended UCITS and other UCIs. Investments may include fixed income instruments with a credit rating below BBB- (Standard & Poor's) or Baa3 (Moody's). 10% of the portfolio must be invested in equities.

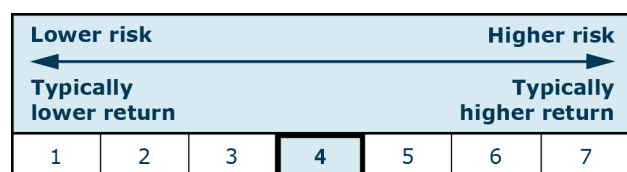
The fund also uses derivatives with the aim of generating additional capital or income. A derivative is a financial instrument which derives its value from the value of an underlying asset. As a result of the use of derivatives, the fund can be leveraged by using derivatives. Usually the expected level of leverage is between 95-225%; maximum expected leverage: 500%. This means that the exposure to underlying assets may be much larger than 100%. Leverage may increase the effects of adverse market movements or decrease the effects of favourable market movements.

Recommendation: This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 3 years.

Benchmark

The fund has no benchmark.

Risk and reward profile



The fund is categorized as 4. The indicator illustrates the typical correlation between the risk and your potential return of the investment. The categorization is determined by the fluctuations in the fund's net asset value over the past five years and/or representative data.

Significant historical volatility equals high risk and low volatility equals lower risk. Please note that the fund's categorization is not constant

and the categorization may change over time. Historical performance data is not necessarily a reliable indicator of the future risk profile.

The principal risks of the fund are equity risk, interest rate risk, credit risk, leverage risk, derivative risk and exchange rate risk. As the fund will invest its assets in both the fixed income and equity markets, the changes in the market conditions and interest rates will affect the return of the fund.

Charges

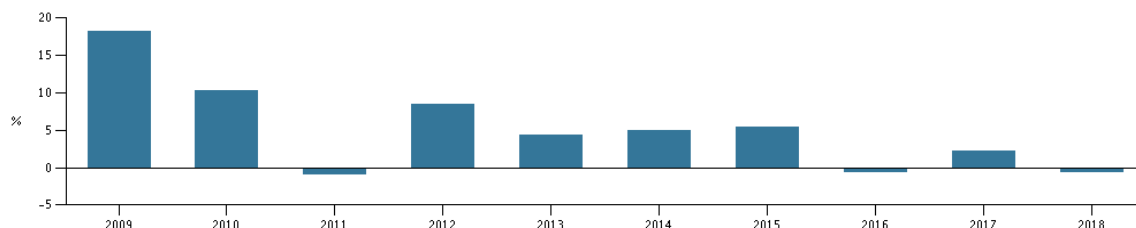
