## Objectives and investment policy

### Objectives

The objective of this fund is to achieve long-term investment growth, while applying an opportunistic asset allocation strategy. The share class is accumulating.

### Investment policy

The fund is a feeder fund, and invests at least 85% of its net assets in class X shares of a master fund, Danske Invest SICAV Global Portfolio Solution - Equities.

The fund may use derivatives only for hedging, such as to hedge some or all of its holdings in the master fund, and the master fund's investments, into NOK.

The master fund gains exposure, directly or through other funds, to a range of asset classes from anywhere in the world, such as equities, bonds and money market instruments. The net exposure to equities usually range from 90% to 100% of the master fund's net assets but may be higher or lower depending on the investment manager's

market outlook. The master fund may gain exposure to any credit quality, sector and country, including emerging markets.

In actively managing the master fund's portfolio, the management team applies a flexible and dynamic asset allocation that seeks to take full advantage of market changes and opportunities.

The master fund may use derivatives for hedging and efficient portfolio management, as well as for investment purposes.

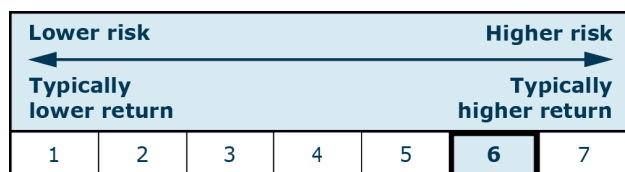
The fund's performance does not fully match that of the master fund due to, in particular, the fund's costs and expenses, its potential use of derivatives and a difference in base currencies.

Recommendation: This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

### Benchmark

## Risk and reward profile



The fund is categorized as 6. The indicator illustrates the typical correlation between the risk and your potential return of the investment. The categorization is determined by the fluctuations in the fund's net asset value over the past five years and/or representative data.
